Application process - top tips



- Know all the Ofqual documentation, where to find it and how it works together
- Make sure you consider the application from an external perspective don't assume the reviewers understand how your organisation works
- Give yourself enough time to complete the summary statements, collate the evidence and present it effectively
- If you are already an operating EPAO take this opportunity to review your practices and ensure they are compliant (don't assume, because you have met RoEPAO requirements, that you meet Ofqual's recognition criteria)
- Make sure you know where your areas for development and rigour are, as well as your strengths
