

Where on-programme assessment can improve validity, reduce burden, improve experiences and outcomes

- Validity is about accuracy the reforms will support proportionate, flexible assessments throughout the learning process, making it a more accurate reflection of an apprentice's overall competency rather than a snapshot of their performance on a single exam
- Spreads the loads of assessment rather than a single high pressure final assessment reducing a single point of burden
- Reduces administrative and assessment burden on the final stages of the onprogramme.

Assessment Plans

Low prescription

- Most common
- Minimum level of prescription
- AOs develop specifications and assessments

Mandatory qualification

- Completion of the qualification or regulatory assessment
- Sole assessment method

Risk-based additional prescription

• Higher risk occupations or regulation demands additional prescription (e.g. safety, regulatory compliance)






APPRENTICESHIP ASSESSMENT REFORM ROADMAP
